DEERWOOD GOLF COURSE UPDATE
(July 29, 2020)

Tee-Times & Payment:

- Individuals wishing to play will be required to make a reservation through our automated tee-time system. Online tee-times can be made through www.deerwoodgc.com or by phone at (716) 245-7708. Members (with a season pass or ID can make reservations within a 7 day window. Non-members can make a reservation within a 4 day window).
- For individual or group of 2 that wish to not be paired with another grouping of golfers, select the “4 golfers” option when making your tee-time.
- Walk-ons are discouraged. Please call ahead for course availability.
- Onsite touchless payment option using CREDIT CARD ONLY is the preferred method of transaction. It alleviates refunds or rainchecks since you pay at the time of your round of golf. If you prefer to prepay you can head to www.deerwoodgc.com and complete online payment for your greens fee by clicking on the “pay online for your round of golf” button.
If you have a SEASON PASS there is no need to pay for greens fees online as your pass covers unlimited rounds of golf.

When You Arrive:

- Be sure you are wearing your mask as you head to the ticket office. (No mask = no service)
- Check in at the ticket office and make payment (if necessary) using touchless credit card transaction. NO CASH transactions are accepted at this time.
- All participants MUST be wearing masks at the time of check-in, as well as while on the practice greens, tee boxes and putting greens if social distancing cannot be maintained. Failure to comply will result in loss of golfing privileges.

Golf carts:

- People not from the same household using the same cart must wear masks while on the cart.
- Understand with many people choosing to have one person per cart, there might be instances where carts will not be immediately available depending on how busy the course is.

On the Course:

- Flag sticks are to remain in place. Cups will be raised so that the ball will not go into the cup. Hitting the cup should be considering “holing” your putt. (Our goal is to reduce contact points as much as possible).
- There will be no ball wash stations or bunker rakes.

- Bathroom facilities will be available to the golfers.

When You Leave:

- If you are eating or drinking at Fairway's Restaurant after your round of golf, please follow the proper social distancing measures they have in place.
- If drinking outside the restaurant refrain from large groupings and maintain proper social distancing. Violators will be asked to leave if they cannot follow proper safety measures in place.

Leagues & Tournament Notes:

- Leagues are permitted to golf; however it is the league contact responsibility to clearly assign tee times to each group of league golfers within the allotted tee times associated with the league. This will help on limiting large gatherings of golfers. Tournaments are permitted to golf but must adhere to all tournament restrictions (see Tournament Guidelines Document).

Purchasing Passes/ID's online:

- At this time we are continuing to offer passes and ID's online at www.ntparksrec.com. You will need your Membership # to complete this process. Due to the nature of our system this is only for previous pass/ID holders.
- You can also renew your pass/ID by phone calling the office at 695-8520.
- New members wishing to obtain a pass can do so by calling 695-8520 and making an appointment to come into the office. Valid Driver's license and additional documentation proving residency is required for a resident ID or pass (example includes insurance card, utility bill, etc).

Our department would like to thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding as we attempt to bring recreational features back to our community in the safest way possible. Your cooperation is key to keeping our course open under the restrictive guidelines set forth by the state. We are all in this together, so stay safe, stay healthy and swing away!
